PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Bus Code Of Conduct Reminder

I want to take a moment to remind everyone of the bus code of conduct for students travelling on a bus before or after school. Busways record all their bus trips and I can access video and audio footage if needed. Poor behaviour on the bus will be followed up with consequences back at school in alignment with our 'school discipline process and procedures' document. It is worth noting that point 1 below refers to standing up and walking down the aisle, hanging legs across the aisles, screaming loudly or any other action that could be deemed as distracting to the bus driver or, if the bus was to stop suddenly, would put the student in more danger.



The Cattai PS Bus code of Conduct

Students will:

- Behave safely at all times.
- Respect the needs and comfort of other passengers.
- Behave appropriately at all times (eg no use of offensive language, fighting, spitting, placing feet on seats or throwing things in or from the bus).
- Protect bus property and report any vandalism.
- Show their travel cards to the driver on boarding and when requested.
- Only use the travel card for its intended purpose.
- Maintain possession of the travel card at all times.

- Follow the driver's instructions about safety on the bus.
- Adhere to the law that bans smoking on buses.
- Adhere to bus operator rules about eating and drinking on the bus.
- Keep arms, legs and other parts of their bodies inside the bus.
- Only attract the attention of the driver in the case of an emergency.
