### Book Week Wrap Up

This week we celebrated book week with the book fair being another huge success which is incredible given that no adults have been able to come onsite to view the fair. The book week parades were adorable as always and it was great to see the students all dressed up in their character costumes. The videos of the book parade have been uploaded to each google classroom and are ready to watch at your own leisure.



### Car Park

I know I placed this in the last newsletter but there are still a number of people, when using the car park of a morning or afternoon, that have not been following the below guidelines. So I will place it here again in the hope that more might read through and follow our advice on how to best use the car park to keep our students and community members safe.

In an effort to make the car park out the front of the school as safe as we possibly can, we have purchased some signage to ensure people are reversing in and parking rear to the fence along the school fence. Our increased enrolment numbers means that there is more traffic at the front of the school for both drop off and pick up. To clarify how we would like for students to safely be picked up and dropped off, I have created a map that helps explain the options available to our community.

**Kiss and drop/bus:** The area is for kiss and drop in the morning. Ideally parents are staying in the car or for the younger students a quick undoing of seat belts and directing them through the front gate. In the afternoon this space is used only for buses. So no pickup from the top gate.

**Rear to fence parking and walk to gate:** All parking spots along fence are rear to fence parking ONLY. If you are parking in these spaces it is expected that you are walking your child to the front gate in the morning and walking with your child from the front gate in the afternoon.

**Park and walk to gate:** This section is for parking your car facing the arrows on the map below and then walking your child to the front gate in the morning or walking with your child from the front gate in the afternoon.

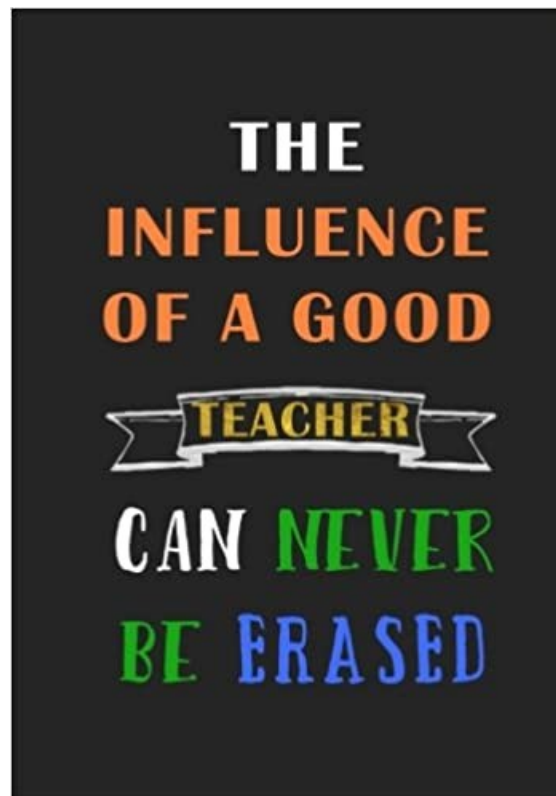
