Car Park Update

At the last P&C meeting I presented a proposed plan for the car park that is located in the council owned road reserve out the front of the school. The plan identified 8 safety concerns and a draft proposal of how these safety concerns could be mitigated. This proposal has been sent on to council and we are eagerly awaiting a response. We don't want to make any promises of what will come of this proposal just to let the community know that we are aware of the issues that parents have been raising to the school and we are doing everything that we can from our end to help fix it. Bushfire Plans

Last week I sat down with our health and safety consultant to update our bush fire response plans. For those of you who are already familiar with our existing plans there are no major changes other than the wording around who and when to signal for a bush fire emergency. Many of the changes have happened in the back ground in regards to streamlining the communication process and wont directly impact the students or community. One does interesting change that impact our community is that if there are catastrophic fire ratings predicted on any given school day due to our school being a category 1 school (the highest bush category) we automatically will cease operations and students will need to be picked up from school or stay home. In the event of this the school will communicate this directly via both Skoolbag and Facebook.

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
