This assessment is a system wide assessment that can be used to track each student to see how they have been progressing since last years check in assessment but also used by Cattai PS teachers to cross reference against our Visible Learning Assessments.

Students from Years 3-6 across both assessments did a fantastic job of completing the tests. Thank you to Mrs Taylor-Morgan for running all these test sessions for the students.

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
