Car Park

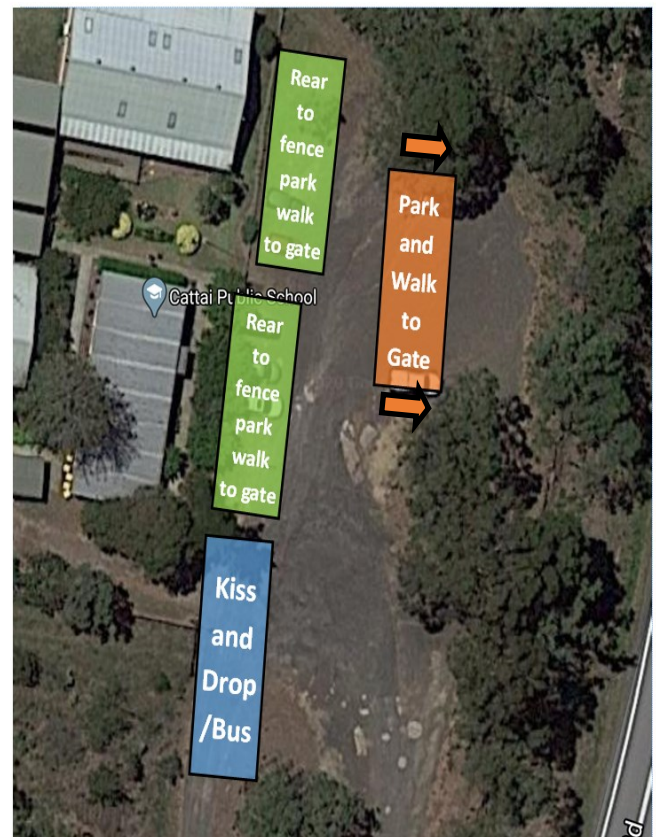
At the moment the school and the P&C have been looking into many options to try and get a long-term solution for our car park. Once I have something concrete I will keep you all informed. So in an effort to make the car park out the front of the school as safe as we possibly can in the meantime, I want to take a moment to remind our everyone about how we would like our community to use the car park on drop off and pick up.

Kiss and drop/bus: The area is for kiss and drop in the morning. Ideally parents are staying in the car or for the younger students a quick undoing of seat belts and directing them through the front gate. In the afternoon this space is used only for buses. So no pickup from the top gate.

Rear to fence parking and walk to gate: All parking spots along fence are rear to fence parking ONLY. If you are parking in these spaces it is expected that you are walking your child to the front gate in the morning and walking with your child from the front gate in the afternoon.

Park and walk to gate: This section is for parking your car facing the arrows on the map below and then walking your child to the front gate in the morning or walking with your child from the front gate in the afternoon.

Thank you everyone for driving with care and caution in this space. In particular, of an afternoon or during school events when we have higher numbers of cars out the front of the school.

C2 talks about Shadow...

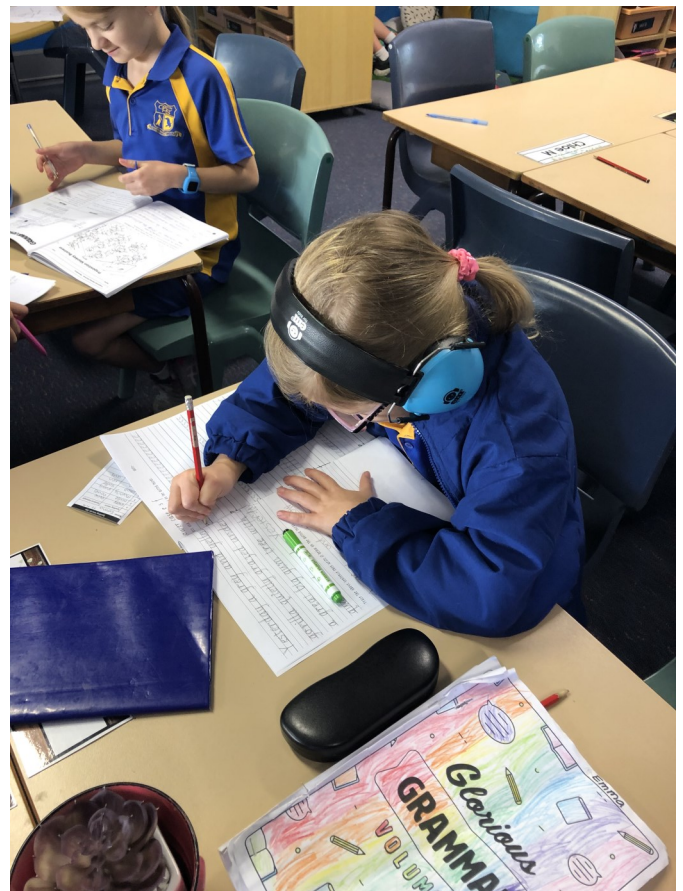
Douglass: We persuaded Miss Saunders to get a fish in our Persuasive writing task.
