P&C Meeting AGM

NAPLAN Practice Session

Coming up on Thursday the 24th March Cattai PS students in Years 3 and 5 will be completing their practice NAPLAN assessment. The practice test serves two purposes. Firstly, to ensure that both the school and state wide technology is up to scratch and that the online platform can handle the large volumes of students that will be participating in the assessment. Secondly, it allows students a chance to be familiar with the platform so that on the day their time can be used to answer questions rather than navigating the platform. There are no marks generated from this assessment.

Check-In Assessment

On Tuesday the 22nd March students will be participating in the check-in assessment. This is for Years 2 and 4 only. The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student's learning.

The Check-in assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

Henny Penny

We have had to push back our Henny Penny program until the start on Term 2. The team at Henny Penny are unable to deliver the chickens as planned next week. The best part of this process is for the students to see them hatch and further delays meant this could of happened during the holidays which wouldn't of been as fun. By moving it to Term 2 now the students and staff will get to see them hatch.
