After the floods there was a large quantity of our sports equipment that we have had to dispose of as it was flood damaged. Insurance will cover this and they will be replaced. But we were able to keep our non-porous equipment. We



have been waiting for this to be aired out and disinfected before we allow the students to reuse this equipment. On Tuesday, we reopened our new sports shed with our salvaged equipment. It has been temporarily relocated to the weather shed and our sport monitors have set up a mini 'sports rental shop' where students can borrow and return equipment at the end of lunch. After a solid week of a shrunken playground and no sports equipment at recess and lunch this change was meet with much excitement from our students.

Future Proofing the Site

Moving forward we have purchased new metal shelving to replace the timber shelving that was in the sports shed. Along with buying milk creates to store sport equipment in. This will allow us to quickly move sports equipment in future floods to higher ground but also make post flood clean up much faster. We have also moved the GA shed to our top shed near the office on higher ground. Over the coming weeks, there is also plans to raise our septic pump and air conditioners to help future proof these assets.

Easter Hat Parade

We have a number of easter celebrations lined up this year to make it special for our students who missed out last year. Teacher will be creating easter hats in class. Traditionally, parents create easter hats with their children and then bring them into parade at school. This year with

floods and COVID staff wanted to help decrease the stress load for parents by making the easter hats in class. However, if making hats is something that you still want to do with your child at home then by all means go for it. The option is yours. Our Easter Parade will take place on Friday the 8th April.

Easter Colouring in Competition and Egg Hunt

Students will also be completing an easter themed colour in competition in class in the next week. There will be a winner from each grade selected and the chocolatey awards will be handed out on the last day at the easter hat parade. On Friday the 8th April, students will have the opportunity to be involved in a whole school easter egg hunt. This is a wonderful tradition and something that our students always look forward to.

On reflecting over the past term I would say that it has been the most challenging starts to a school year since I began in education many moons ago. Certainly schools have never faced both COVID and floods at the same time. Throughout the term the students, staff and community have once again shown why I love working with this this amazing community.
